

PLATFORM REGISTRATION AND COURSE ENROLLMENT: ENGLISH COURSE



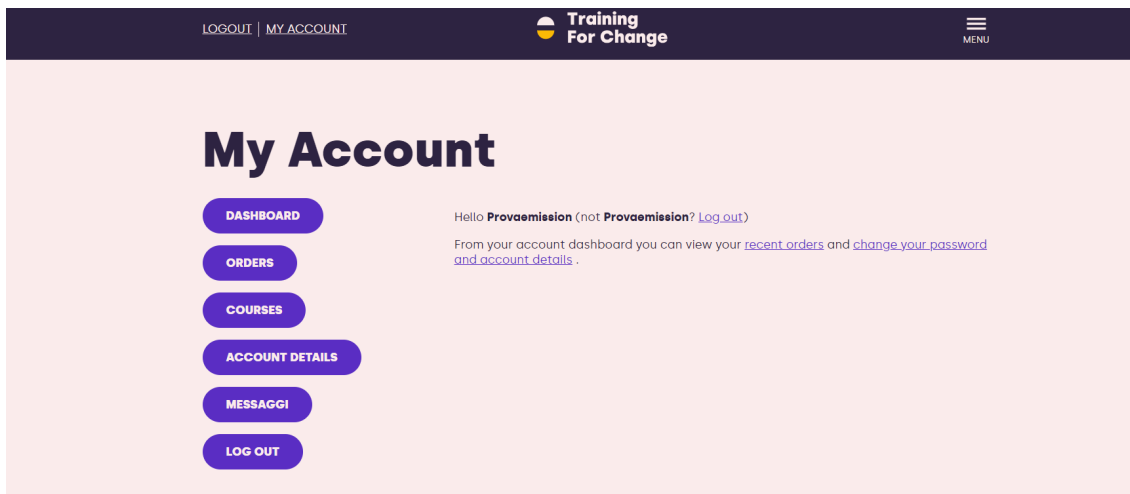
Follow the steps below:

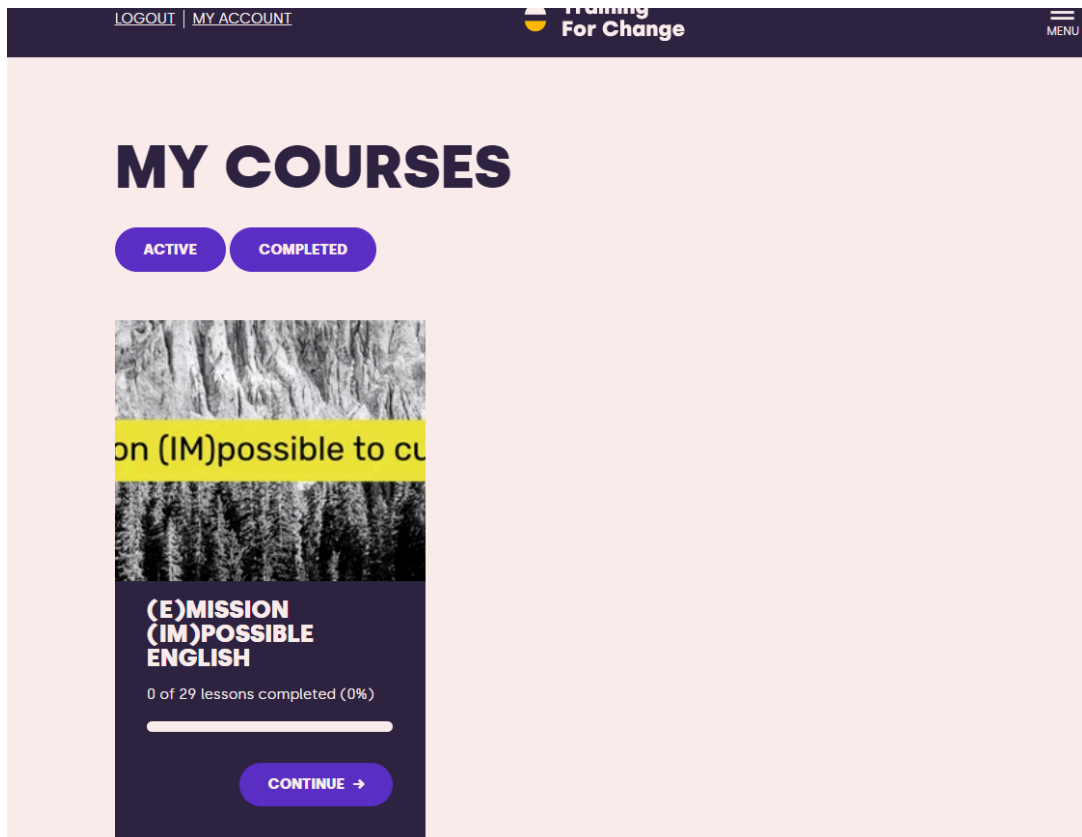
5. You will now arrive at this page (image below) and can click on MY ACCOUNT:



6. Click on COURSES (image below)

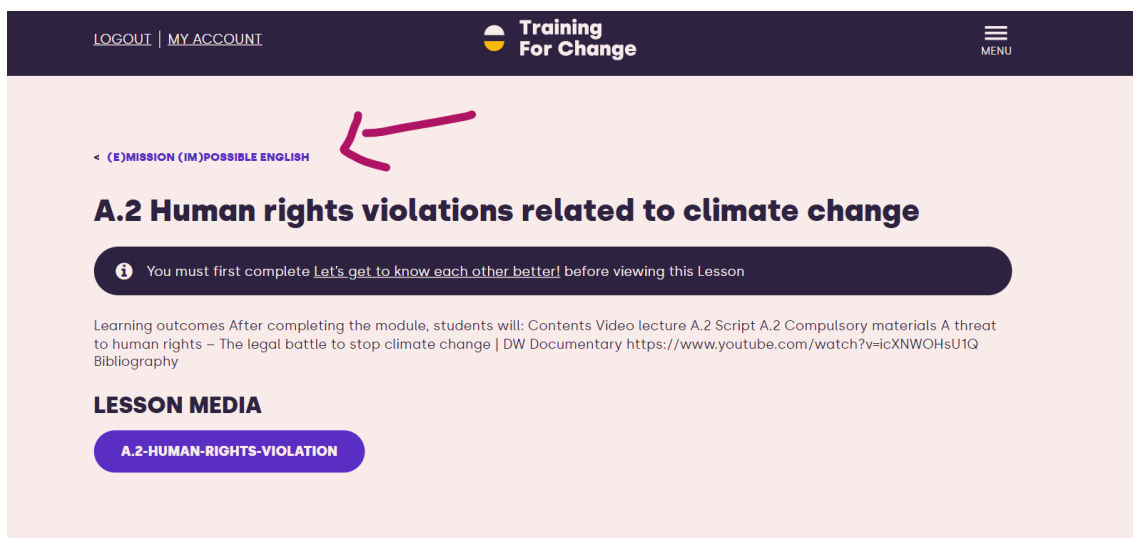


7. Here you'll find the (e)mission (im)possible course (image below). We recommend saving this page in your browser so that you can easily access it each time and check the progress of the course.




8. Click on CONTINUE to start the course.

9. Here you are back on the main course page, where you can now view and access all the lessons!



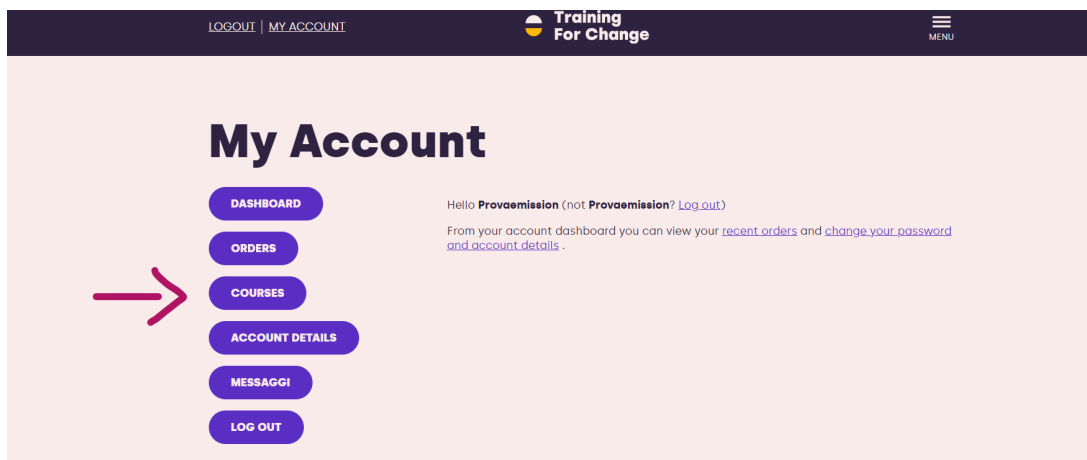
